## Program

- ◇ Monthly rental subsidy that decreases over a 6-month period
- ◇ Phased program addresses physical and mental health needs, facilitates goal-setting, life skill development and networking with services to support self-sufficiency
- ◇ Supported by Christian allies
- ◇ Guided by a professional Navigator

## SERVE

Volunteer allies and advocates are trained to provide emotional and spiritual support, assist with life skills, and encourage participants

## Qualifications

- ✓ Resident of Love INC service area for at least 9 months; this includes Hummelstown, Hershey, and the Dauphin County portion of Elizabethtown
- ✓ Late or unable to pay rent for at least 2 of the last 6 months
- ✓ Family has a sustainable source of income other than county assistance and/or social security
- ✓ Applicant is able to physically live and function independently
- ✓ Rental property must comply with the PA Implied Warranty of Habitability
- ✓ Applicant and household members do not have criminal charges against another person
