
The Homes of Hope

Transitional Program

- Temporary single-family housing for up to 18 months
- Phased program addresses physical and mental health needs, facilitates goal-setting, life skill development and networking with services to support self-sufficiency
- Supported by Christian allies
- Guided by a professional Case Manager

SERVE

Volunteer advocates are trained to provide emotional and spiritual support, assist with life skills, and encourage participants.

Volunteer Maintenance and Procurement teams keep the house comfortable and safe for participants.

Qualifications

- Individual or Family that is homeless or facing eviction (including those living in a hotel/motel)
- Family has a sustainable source of income other than county assistance and/or social security.
- √ Family's last permanent residence is/ was within the Love INC of Greater Hershey service area.
- Applicant is able to physically live and function independently.
- √ Applicant and household members do not have criminal charges against another person.

Applicant assessment is a multi-step process to determine readiness for working towards self-sufficiency.
